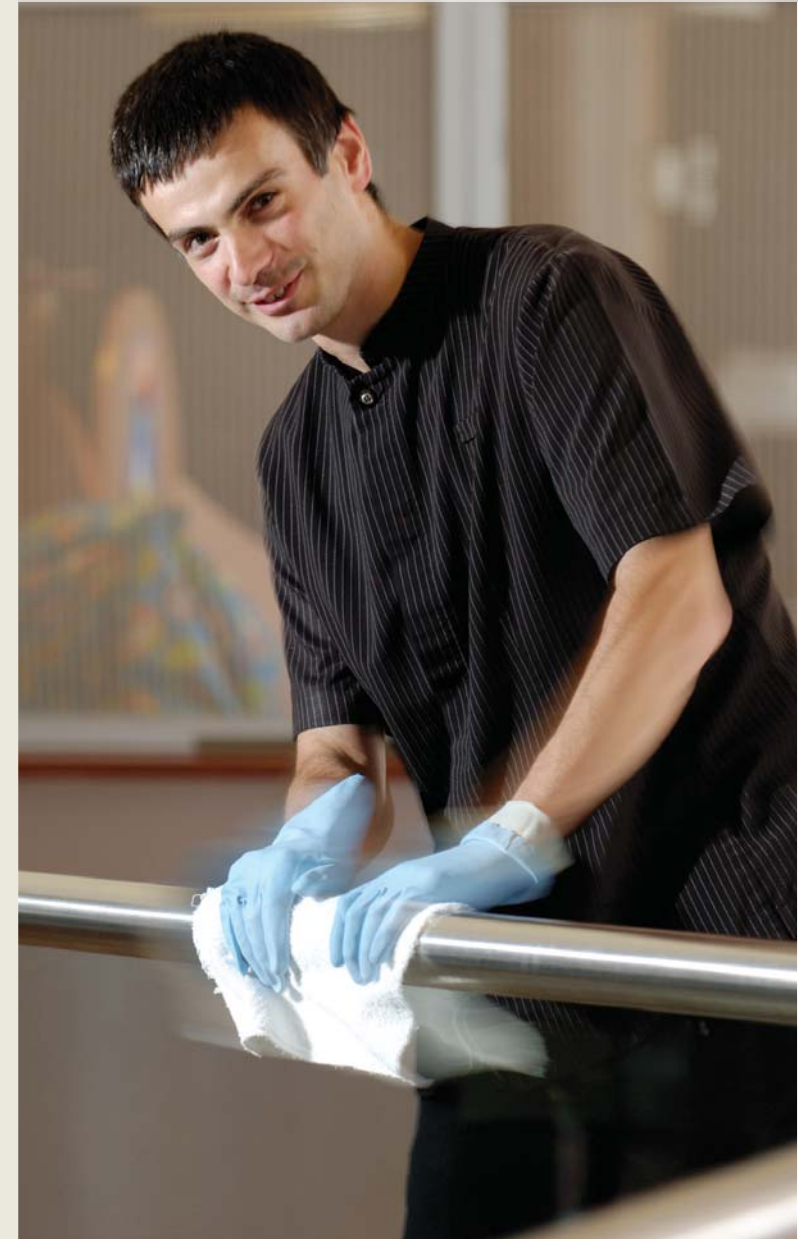

DSA for Employment Options

DSA for employment

At Disability Services Australia our focus is on achieving positive outcomes for people with a disability. By providing a range of options to suit a variety of requirements, we offer a comprehensive suite of services to assist people with a disability who have employment as a goal.

We are continually breaking down the barriers to enable people with a disability to move from service to service as their needs change and as they develop new skills.



121 Employment assists people to find and keep a job in the open labour market across the greater Sydney region. 121 Employment also provides specialist assistance to people with a mental health issue.

121 Employment is an open employment service (DEN) for people with a disability funded by the Commonwealth Government. Assistance offered includes career planning, interview practice, resume writing, marketing for jobs and support maintaining employment.

Work experience placements are also available with our Business Services for people with a disability.



DSA Employment is a Supported Employment service for people with a disability funded by the Commonwealth Government. Employment is provided in a number of Business Service sites across Sydney – Mascot, Condell Park, Castle Hill and Braemar.

The employee is paid a training wage for the initial 3-6 months of employment. At the completion of training, an independent assessment is made to determine the ongoing hourly rate of pay (using the Business Service Wage Assessment Tool or BSWAT). Transition To Work (TTW) at Disability Services Australia is a 2 year work readiness program funded by the Department of Aging Disability and Home Care (DADHC). The program aims to equip recent school leavers with the skills for work that will assist them to achieve their employment goal. TTW is a practical introduction to the workplace and includes pre-vocational skills, travel training and how to get and keep a job.
