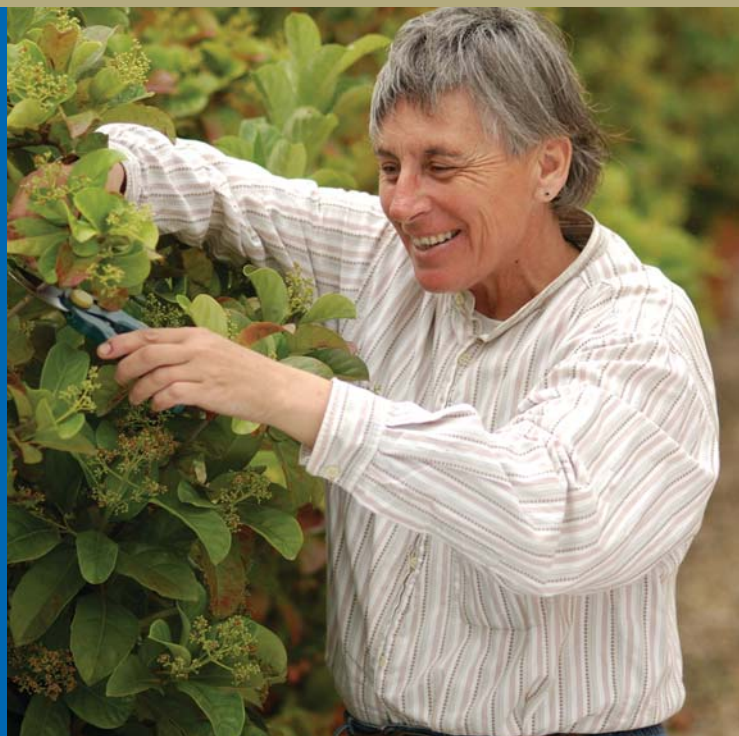


## History

## Traineeships and fee for service courses

**mets** offer Traineeships/FFS in both CIII and CIV in Disability Services.

### Traineeships

- Government incentives may be available to employers
- Traineeships are subsidised and students pay a once-only enrolment fee
- Conditions apply for eligibility
